This year we are holding a series of 4 events across England and Wales, each providing an introduction to the work of national charity, POPYRUS Prevention of Young Suicide.



Suicide is a leading cause of death among our young people. POPYRUS seeks to work with communities across the UK to tackle the stigma that surrounds suicide and to promote mental health and wellbeing among young people and those who care for and work with young people.

Ged Flynn, POPYRUS Chief Executive, will help participants to

- ↳ examine our attitudes to and beliefs about suicide
- ↳ explore what causes stigma around suicide
- ↳ increase awareness of the scale of young suicidal ideation and behaviours
- ↳ to develop knowledge, skills, and attitudes which may help prevent young
- ↳ think about developing local responses in our own dioceses, parishes, schools, communities, networks and organisations to help to **#saveyounglives**
