Paul Gilbert FBPsS PhD, OBE is Professor of Clinical Psychology at the University of Derby and Consultant Clinical Psychologist at the Derbyshire Health Care Foundation Trust. He has researched evolutionary approaches to psychopathology for over 35 years focusing on the treatment of shame- based difficulties - for which compassion focused therapy was developed. In 2003 he was president of the BABCP and a member of the first NICE committee on depression. written/edited 20 books and over 150 papers. In 2006 he established the Compassionate Mind Foundation charity with the mission statement "To promote wellbeina through the scientific understanding and application of compassion" (www.compassionatemind.co.uk).
