- examine our attitudes to and beliefs about suicide
- explore what causes stigma around suicide
- increase awareness of the scale of young suicidal ideation and behaviours

- think about developing local responses in our own dioceses, parishes, schools, communities, networks and organisations to help to **#saveyounglives**
