Fr Dominic Robinson SJ.

<u>This year's focus</u>: Following the two synods of the Roman Catholic Church which met to discuss issues concerning "the family" in 2014 and 2015, we will hear from Bishops Peter and Tim who attended the second of the two Synods. They will talk about their experiences as participant and observer and reflect on the outcomes of the discussions from the particular perspective.

By the time we meet it is expected that the Pope will have responded to the Bishops' final Synod paper and we will have a chance to discuss the papal "Exhortation" with our speakers. Throughout our conversations both with the speakers and with other members, we will reflect on the role and needs of interchurch families today in the church and the world.

Worship & prayer are central to the weekend and all ages are involved in the liturgy and the music. There will be a Roman Catholic Mass and another service, this year in the Anglican tradition.

<u>Who is it for?</u> All couples in an interchurch marriage or thinking about such a marriage, and interchurch children of any age. Clergy and others interested in the pastoral care of interchurch families are also most welcome.

<u>Children are welcome</u> and will enjoy their own separate, but integrated programme, those aged 15 and over may elect to join the main programme or take part in the Young Adults Group (YAG).

How much does it cost?

The fees for the AIF Weekend include all meals. There <u>may</u> be a very few non en-suite rooms available. Please specify if you would prefer this on your booking form and we will try to accommodate you.
